

ORDINANCE NO. 18-023

PRIVATE

AN ORDINANCE ASCERTAINING THE PREVAILING RATE OF WAGES FOR LABORERS, WORKMEN AND MECHANICS EMPLOYED ON PUBLIC WORKS OF THE CITY OF MONMOUTH

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted “An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workmen employed in any public works by the State, County, County or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public work,” approved June 26, 1941, as amended, being 820 ILCS 130/1 through 820 ILCS 130/12; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires the City Council of the City of Monmouth, Illinois investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workmen in the locality of said township employed in performing construction of public works, for said town exclusive of maintenance work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONMOUTH, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1:

To the extent and as required by “An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workmen employed in any public works by the State, County, City or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works,” approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workmen engaged in the construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of this town is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Warren County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of June 1, 2017, a copy of that determination is being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

Section 2:

Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the City to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

Section 3:

The City Clerk shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of this City this determination of such prevailing rate of wage.

Section 4:

The City Clerk shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed, or file

their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workmen whose wages will be affected by such rates.

Section 5:

The City Clerk shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with both the Secretary of State and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

Section 6:

The City Clerk shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area or publish in pamphlet form a copy of this Ordinance, and such publication shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.
