*MPD officers assisted America's Run For The Fallen as they passed by the edge of Monmouth going East. This is one of the most comprehensive fallen military tributes conducted as runners run across the U.S. starting at Ft. Irwin California and ending at Arlington National Cemetery.

*Chief Switzer gave a talk during the June Warren County Triad meeting. Questions asked by the audience ranged from parking issues, noise complaints and animal complaints.

*Police Officer testing was scheduled for June 16th, however the testing was postponed due to the lack of applications that had been turned in. Efforts will be made to get the testing information out again in hopes of having more applications turned in.

*Two arrests were made where methamphetamine was involved and 3 new cases were opened that involve methamphetamine and heroin.
