INCIDENTS OF NOTE:

- *Prime Beef Festival run and parade were held. The run was cancelled due to the impending weather. The parade started however a storm came in and cut the parade short. In the future, MPD will assist the event organizers with determining the cancelation of an event. This was the first time in my 26 years at MPD that the parade had to be called off; unfortunately about a third of the parade had already started on the route.
- *No incidents reported at the beer tent for the Prime Beef Festival.
- *ALICE training was conducted at Monmouth-Roseville Jr. High School and at Central Intermediate.
- *MPD Chaplains held a family day cookout for MPD officers and families. Approximately 25 people attended.
- *To date, 37 people who work for liquor license holders were trained by MPD to receive their BASSET certification. In the coming months, compliance checks will begin at liquor establishments for BASSET credentials.

STAFF TRAINING:

- *Officers attended training for Mental Health Awareness.
- *Officer attended Sexual Assault training.
- *Chief Switzer attended the Warren County Emergency Partners meeting.
- *Two MPD officers went to Basic Truck Enforcement training for overweight truck enforcement. We are now coordinating with ISP to come to Monmouth to conduct enforcement of overweight trucks.

EQUIPMENT RELATED ISSUES:

- *AC unit that supplies the North side of MPD was serviced due to it not cooling that portion of the building.
